WHAT IS THE SCORE PORTAL?

Developed by SCORE, a consortium of 7 leading organizations in surgical education, the portal:

- Is a web-based learning system providing residents and programs high-quality educational content
- Supports a new national curriculum in general surgery residency training
- Provides residents easy access to materials to support learning and self-study
- Helps programs and faculty facilitate instruction and align their program with SCORE's new curriculum

HOW IT WORKS

Currently the portal contains learning modules for 3 competencies aligned with SCORE's curriculum outline:

- 250+ modules on Patient Care topics
- 70+ modules on Medical Knowledge topics
- 30 modules on Systems-Based Practice topics

Content is continually added and updated. Each module provides Learning Objectives, Resources, and Learning Activities.

USEFUL FEATURES OF THE PORTAL INCLUDE:

- **Carefully selected material from leading sources** such as *ACS Surgery: Principles and Practice*, *Greenfield's Surgery: Scientific Principles and Practice*, and *Cameron's Atlas of Gastrointestinal Surgery*
- **ACS Surgery Weekly Curriculum**, weekly clinical cases and multiple choice questions to assess knowledge—now in Junior and Senior tracks
- Access to **hundreds of radiological and anatomical images** via StatDx
- Access to **Evidence Based Reviews in Surgery**, an online journal club
- **30 modules from MDContent**, related to Systems-Based Practice for PGY-3 to PGY-5 residents
- **Operative videos**
- The ability to **create and give assignments** and track residents' progress
- **ABSITE practice questions**
